Classification

Pullman Regional Hospital in Pullman, Washington has been using the DocuWare ECM for over 10 years to process medical records. With the volume of patient records, it is imperative that the document

classification is automated. Medical records are scanned and imported into a DocuWare file cabinet. **The Classification engine, using OCR phrase matching, identifies patient forms automatically and puts them into the correct sections of the electronic medical record.**

Automatic classification of documents reduces the amount of time required to identify documents, allows the medical record staff to quickly identify any document deficiencies and, most importantly, allows caregivers to view the correct documents at the point of care.

The Classification engine runs automatically and is configured for each document.
