


Deficiency Manager

The Medical Records department at Barnes-Jewish Hospital releases 10,000 or more patient records per month. Until recently, the process was completely managed with paper. Notification Management

StapleWare® Notification Management will send email notifications to a user or group of users based on document index data in a DocuWare file cabinet. This includes email addresses that are outside of DocuWare.

Notification Management can also send email notifications for documents missing from a file cabinet. This feature allows the Notification Management Module to work with The **StapleWare® Deficiency Manager** to identify missing documents and notify users that they must take corrective action to complete any set of documents.



Notification Management's functionality is enhanced by the DocuWare AutoIndex module. AutoIndex has the ability to update index values based on variable dates in the future and in the past. By allowing AutoIndex to change field values based on variable dates, Notification Management can recurrently send notifications for documents such as renewal contracts.
